

**MARION COUNTY WATER DISTRICT
CUSTOMER NOTICE**

Notice is hereby given that the Marion County Water District proposes to make the following revisions to its schedule of rates and charges for services effective May 1, 2026. An application to revise the District’s Tariff is expected to be filed with the Kentucky Public Service Commission on or about March 30, 2026 to modify the rate schedule such that all customers will be billed a minimum monthly charge that includes up to 1,500 gallons of water usage. Any water used above 1,500 gallons will be billed per gallon at the current volumetric rate.

If the Public Service Commission approves the proposed water rates, the monthly water bill for a customer using an average of 3,989 gallons per month will remain unchanged.

The charges/rates contained in this notice are the charges/rates proposed by the Marion County Water District. However, the Public Service Commission may order charges/rates to be charged that differ from these proposed charges/rates. Such action may result in charges/rates for consumers other than the charges/rates in this notice.

Written comments may be submitted to the Public Service Commission through its Web site or by mail to Public Service Commission, Post Office Box 615, Frankfort, Kentucky 40602.

A person may submit a timely written request for intervention to the Public Service Commission, Post Office Box 615, Frankfort, Kentucky 40602, establishing the grounds for the request including the status and interest of the party. If the commission does not receive a written request for intervention within thirty (30) days of the initial publication or mailing of the notice, the commission may take final action on the tariff filing.
